




We, the undersigned members of the Cuyahoga Valley Civil War Roundtable, one of the oldest organizations of Civil War laypersons in the state of Ohio, urge each of you to oppose the gambling facility proposed for Adams County, Pennsylvania.

Gettysburg is an American shrine; it is hallowed ground, sanctified by the courage, honor, devotion, and ultimate sacrifices of the thousands of Americans who converged upon the unsuspecting community over one-hundred forty years ago. Those timeless acts of heroism and valor, embodied in the ineffable physical, emotional, and military losses of those fateful July days—came to be consecrated by the harmonious and healing words a great American, President Abraham Lincoln, whose Gettysburg Address is today a divine discourse that defines our nation.

Since the day Lincoln traveled to Gettysburg in November 1863, millions of Americans have followed in his footsteps in each passing year to experience their nation's history on the now deathless acres of Gettysburg National Military Park. Likewise, they pay their respects at the Gettysburg National Cemetery, the nation's first national sepulcher. Within the silence of these acres, the history lessons abound, emanating from silent cannon and bronze sculptures to transfix even the most casual observer.

This is the function of a historic site. A place where the events of the past can come into and touch our lives; a place to quietly reflect on great carnage and even greater convictions. A place that has been set aside by the work of previous generations as sacred.

To build a gaudy gambling facility on property so near to this location of national importance, where men fought and died for its perpetuation, is not only irreverent and ignorant to history—it is sacrilegious. A place hallowed for our posterity is not the place to build a mocking casino that would decimate the solemnity of Gettysburg and ultimately lead to a sprawl of development that would pose further challenges to the

battlefield.

Joshua Lawrence Chamberlain, who earned the Congressional Medal of Honor for his actions in the Battle of Gettysburg on July 2, once wrote of the Gettysburg battlefield:

*In great deeds, something abides. On great fields, something stays.
Forms change and pass, bodies disappear, but spirits linger— to pass into the
vision- place of souls. And men and women from afar, generations that know us
not and that we not know of, heart drawn to see where and by whom great things
were done for them, shall come to this deathless field to ponder and dream.*

We want the millions of Americans that come to Gettysburg each year to continue to ponder and dream on that great field, and with equal fervor, we hope that their grandchildren will be able to do the same. Building a casino straddling the Gettysburg battlefield is certainly not commemorating that ground for our generation and for our posterity. Therefore, we, the undersigned, regardless of our own political ideologies and personal opinions with respect to gambling, are united in fervent opposition to this ludicrous proposal.







On behalf of the Preservation Alliance for Greater Philadelphia, I write to express our opposition to Chance Enterprises' application for a license to build a casino with up to 5,000 slot machines within a mile of Gettysburg National Military Park. We believe a casino is at odds with the historical values of both the battlefield and the town.

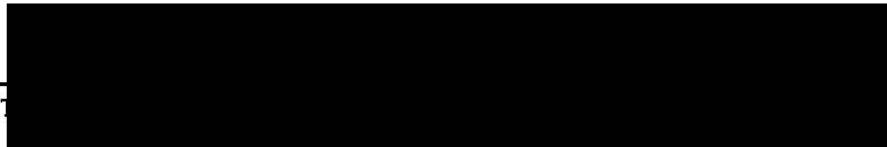
While our mission is to promote the appreciation, protection, and revitalization of the Philadelphia area's historic buildings, communities, and landscapes, the threat of a casino so close to one of our national treasures warrants the Alliance taking a stand. In addition to the battlefield, the town of Gettysburg has many important historical structures that illustrate what life was like before, during and after the battle. It is these structures, many which still bear scars from July 1863, that allow visitors to step back in time and learn about the history that shaped who we are as a nation today.

For example, consider the Rupp House. With the original portion of the house predating the Civil War, the Rupp house was at the center of a portion of the battle of Gettysburg. The owner, John Rupp, hid in the basement during the fighting, later describing in a letter that there were Union soldiers on the front porch and Confederate soldiers on the back, with the two armies firing at each other through the house. In 2002, Friends of the National Parks at Gettysburg acquired the property and in 2003 opened the Rupp House History Center, which offers visitors a glimpse of what life was like for the civilians of Gettysburg—as well as for the soldiers—during the battle.

Private groups such as the Friends and public interests including the National Park Service have invested millions of dollars in protecting and interpreting Gettysburg's history. I urge you to protect Gettysburg's future by denying Chance Enterprise's application for a gaming license.


