PGCB RESOLUTION NO. 2005-4 REG – Adoption of the Draft Regulations as Temporary Regulations for the General Licensing Standards for Slot Machine License Applicants

Whereas On July 5, 2004, the Pennsylvania General Assembly enacted the

Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act, establishing the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board as the primary regulatory agency charged with the responsibility of implementing and overseeing slot

machine gaming in the Commonwealth; and

Whereas The Act authorizes the Board to adopt "temporary" regulations in order to

facilitate the prompt implementation of the Act during the two years

following the Act's effective date; and

Whereas The Board has developed draft temporary regulations for the general

licensing standards for slot machine license applicants, specific licensing requirements for the Category 1 slot machine license applicants and

compulsive and problem gambling requirements; and

Whereas The public has had an opportunity to comment on the draft temporary

regulations, and the Board has incorporated appropriate public comments

into the regulations; and

Whereas The Board's final temporary regulations are designated as Title 58

Recreation, Part VII Gaming Control Board:

 Subpart C Slot Machine Licensing, specifically Chapter 441 Slot Machine Licenses; and Chapter 443 Categories of Licensure and

 Subpart H Compulsive and Problem Gambling, specifically Chapter 501 Compulsive and Problem Gambling Requirements

and

Whereas The Board reserves the right to amend the temporary regulations as it

deems necessary in accordance with the purpose of the Act and in order to

further the intent of the Act; be it

RESOLVED That the Board adopts the draft regulations as its temporary regulations for

the general licensing standards for slot machine license applicants, specific licensing requirements for the Category 1 slot machine license applicants

and compulsive and problem gambling requirements.
