Meeting of the Board May 1, 2007

Minutes

A meeting of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board was held on May 1, 2007 in the State Museum Auditorium. The meeting began at 11:08 a.m.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chairman Decker announced that the Board held executive sessions on April 30 and prior to the meeting to discuss personnel matters. No business was conducted at these sessions. He also announced that the application period for Category 3 licenses will open April 20 and close June 29. Chairman Decker announced that the Board will be accepting applications for the Local Law Enforcement Grant Program from May 15 to June 29.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Anne Neeb provided the Board with an update on the activities of the agency and staff remaining fully engaged with the licensees in both the start-up of the operations and expansions. Ms. Neeb stated that Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs and Sands Bethworks have both scheduled ground breaking ceremonies. She further stated that the gaming revenue at the opened facilities continue to exceed the amounts estimated. Ms. Neeb indicated that gaming has gotten off to good start.

Ms. Neeb stated that Glenn Payton has recently been appointed to the position as Director of the Office of Professional Responsibility for the PGCB.
