Meeting of the Board April 7, 2010 Minutes

A meeting of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board was held on April 7, 2010 at the Temple University-Harrisburg Campus, Lecture Hall, Harrisburg, PA. The meeting began at approximately 10:00 a.m.

A quorum of the Board being present, Chairman Fajt called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chairman Fajt announced that the Board held an Executive session on April 6th and just prior to today's meeting in accordance with the Sunshine Act. The purpose of the executive session held yesterday was to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation, and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters pending before the Board. He stated that the executive session held following the public hearings were to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relative to those hearings.

MINUTES AND TRANSCRIPTS

On a motion by Board Member Angeli, seconded by Board Member Coy, the minutes and transcripts of the March 3, 2010 meeting was approved.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Kevin O'Toole, Executive Director updated the Board on slot-machine generated revenue at the 9 operating casinos in Pennsylvania stating that it increased by 29% during March 2010 compared to March 2009. He commented that the increase in revenue for March signals a good outlook as the casinos approach the spring and summer months.

Mr. O'Toole reported that the casinos as well as the staff of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board are moving forward toward the implementation of table games pointing out that the meeting agenda reflects some of those steps with 3 more Petitions for Table Game Operation Certificates being considered and temporary regulations for table game equipment standards.

In closing, he stated that various members of our staff are making regular visits to the casinos to check on the progress that is being made in renovating the casino floor layouts to accommodate table games alongside slot machines. Mr. O'Toole also commented that training of table game dealers have commenced at 6 of the casinos and efforts are continuing with drafting accounting and internal controls for table game operations.
