A quorum of the Board being present, Chairman Ryan called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Board held an Executive Session on December 10, 2013. The purpose of the Executive Session was to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation, and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters being considered by the Board on December 11, 2013

MINUTES & TRANSCRIPTS

On a motion by Commissioner Fajt, seconded by Commissioner Kaiser the minutes and transcript of the October 30, 2013 meeting were approved.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Kevin O'Toole, Executive Director announced that this past November, the General Assembly enacted Act 90 of 2013, which is generally referred to as the Tavern Gaming Law. The Governor signed this Act into law on November 27, 2013 and it becomes effective on January 27, 2014. Mr. O'Toole stated that this legislation is important to the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board because the General Assembly incorporated into the Tavern Gaming Law a provision assigning the responsibility to conduct background investigations to the PGCB's Bureau of Investigations and Enforcement. It is a well-

deserved recognition to BIE to be asked by the General Assembly to perform this important role within the Tavern Gaming Bill.

Mr. O'Toole explained that Director Paul Mauro and Chief Enforcement Counsel Cyrus Pitre and their staffs have met with representatives of the Liquor Control Board to discuss all relevant issues. The cooperation between our agencies in this endeavor has been outstanding and it will insure a smooth implementation of this law in a manner that fulfills the Legislature's intent.

In closing, Mr. O'Toole explained that an investigative fee will be paid by each applicant for a Tavern Gaming License that will cover all or part of the reasonable and necessary costs of the background investigation. Additional costs and expenses, if necessary, will be billed to the applicants for actual expenses when the background investigation is completed.

As the process moves forward, he indicated that he will provide additional updates to the Board on the Tavern Gaming Law.
