# Parx Casino

OP-16 - High Limit Pit Approval Request

April 14, 2011





The Board has granted all relief requested in the OP-16 petition, except the request to implement the 14 table game new high limit pit (Pit #7) in Parx Casino.





## ■ The OP-16 petition requested six items of relief:

- Activate poker tables at Parx East 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.
- Move 23 converted Shuffle Master E-tables (15 to Parx East 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor and 8 to Parx Casino, inside table games ellipse).
- Move 93 slots out of slot zone FG to make room for development of high limit table game pit (Pit #7).
- Implement use of 14 table games in the proposed new high limit pit (Pit #7).
- Add 50 banking table games at Parx East 1<sup>st</sup> floor.
- Reconfigure slots and table games in Parx Casino as detailed in the narrative of changes attached as Exhibit A to the petition.
  - This narrative included the movement or relocation of a total of 405 slot machines and 14 table games in Parx Casino (two of which were to be removed from the gaming floor)





- PGCB order dated 12/16/2010 specified only four items of approval:
  - Add 50 banking table games at Parx East 1<sup>st</sup> floor.
  - Add 21 poker tables at Parx East 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.
  - Move 23 converted Shuffle Master E-tables (15 to Parx East 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and 8 to Parx Casino, inside table games ellipse).
  - Move 93 slots out of slot zone FG to make room for development of high limit table game pit (Pit #7).





- Subsequent letters and authorizations from the Board confirmed the balance of the relief requested in the petition, with the exception of the high limit pit approval now before the Board.
- 1. Letter from Executive Director dated 1/12/2011 approved relocation of 145 slot machines.
  - The letter included the 93 slots referred to in the 12/16/2010 order plus 52 slots that had been previously approved for movement in the OP-14C application.





2. Authorization to Commence Slot Operations dated 1/31/2011 authorized the operation of 3,391 slot machines, which is consistent with the relief requested in OP-16 (3,351 slot machines + 40 E-table slot seats yet to be converted to FAEGTs = 3,391 slot positions).





3. Letter from Executive Director dated 2/24/2011 approved the operation and use of 15 FAEGT BJ games at Parx East 3<sup>rd</sup> floor (as requested in the OP-16 petition).





4. Letter from Executive Director dated 3/1/2011 confirmed the table game mix at Parx Casino (55 games) as had been requested in the OP-16 petition.




#### **OP-16 – High Limit Pit Approval Request**

## Anticipated Construction and Implementation Schedule

- Room has been under construction since January 2011, following the December 2010 OP16 approval.
- Place table games in pit by May 15, 2011.
- Systems checks & approvals by May 25, 2011.
- Open games to public on May 27, 2011.



### Table Mix, Jobs and Revenue

- 14 tables will be installed in Pit #7
  - 4 midi-baccarat
  - 8 blackjack
  - 1 roulette
  - 1 craps
- Anticipated incremental revenue from these tables is \$20,000,000 per year, with \$2,800,000 per year in gaming taxes paid to the state and \$400,000 per year paid to Bensalem Township as its local share.
- New full-time jobs established by the 14 new table games will be 34:
  - 24 dealers
  - 10 supervisors
