






- Poker Room addition includes:
  - Relocation of 15 table-top thoroughbred racing betting units.
  - Relocation of the pari-mutuel cashiers to another location on the second floor.
  - Additional self betting machines for pari-mutuel wagering including one in the poker room.
  - Addition and relocation of TV monitors to enhance the racing broadcast viewing, including additional monitors in the poker room.

- The poker room will be located on the second floor of the grandstand.
- Consists of 2,028 square feet new gaming space.
- It will contain nine (9) poker tables and a cashiers cage.
- A self betting unit will be installed to facilitate thoroughbred wagering.





# Economic Impact

- **■** Poker Room construction estimate \$400,000
- Poker Revenue Forecast \$2.3 Million annualized
- Gaming Taxes and Fees \$402,500 annualized



- Annually \$880,000 + payroll taxes and benefits


#### Surveillance

- One (1) stationary camera will be located above each poker table.
- **■** Four (4) PTZ cameras will be located within the room.
- Two (2) stationary cameras will cover one each entrance/exit.
- □ Two (2) stationary cameras will provide broad coverage of the poker room.



Surveillance:

- Cashiers Cage
  - One (1) PTZ camera
  - Seven (7) fixed cameras including patron facial coverage and down shot cameras



#### Security:

One (1) permanent fixed post will be located at the entrance to the poker room which will be manned when the room is open.
