Comprehensive Plan



- SugarHouse's Audit Committee met on October 14, 2016 and authorized the company to develop and implement a Comprehensive Underage Plan.
- The Plan was sent to OEC staff on November 10, 2016.

Comprehensive Plan



- New Equipment
 - Hardwired machines with state of the art technology and periodic software updates
- Training
 - Additional training by outside firm on identifying fake IDs



 Progressive discipline, incentives, surveillance audit and redeployment of Class 2 officers at front doors




Comprehensive Plan



- Outreach and awareness
 - Local universities, Pennsylvania State
 Police, Philadelphia Family Court
 - New signage at front doors
- State law amendments
 - Misdemeanors for subsequent offenses, driver's license suspensions
- State Police involvement
 - Troopers respond when fake IDs are detected at the front door





Recent success



- No underage violations in over 3 months.
- In calendar year 2016, SugarHouse carded **230,725** patrons and turned **16,635** (7.2%) away for not having proper identification.
- Since November 1, 2016, SugarHouse has carded 50,504 patrons and turned 4,244 (8.4%) away for not having proper identification.
 - During this period, SugarHouse caught 11 individuals attempting to use fake IDs at the front door.
