Thank you, ladies and gentlemen. Today, we will have closing arguments in the Category 2 Applications pending for the City of Philadelphia. These will take place prior to our regular public meeting. Our first order of business will be consideration of Stadium Casino, LLC's motion to reopen the record, so that they may amend their application as it pertains to a restructuring of Sterling Fiduciary Services, Incorporated, the corporate trustee for the Sterling Investor's Trust, which would be licensed as a principle were Stadium to be awarded a license.

Since no party to the Category 2 proceedings has filed an objection to the Petition, the Board will decide the matter based upon the motion submitted and the Office of Enforcement Counsel's (OEC) response, which have previously been reviewed by the Board. May I have a motion?

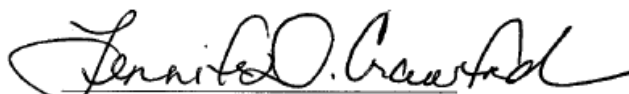
15 Thank you, Mr. Kohler. Next, we will be
