Down Under Blackjack; Table Game Rules of Play

We submit for your consideration the following comments on the proposed rulemaking published in the September 22, 2018 *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. Our comments are based on criteria in Section 5.2 of the Regulatory Review Act (71 P.S. § 745.5b). Section 5.1(a) of the Regulatory Review Act (71 P.S. § 745.5a(a)) directs the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (Board) to respond to all comments received from us or any other source.

Clarity.

We have identified three minor clarity concerns with this proposed rulemaking. First, the definitions listed in § 685a.1 (relating to definitions) should be listed in alphabetical order. Second, § 685a.3 (relating to cards; number of decks; value of cards) contains two subsections eited as $\underline{\mathbf{d}}$. (Emphasis added.) The second subsection should be amended to $\underline{\mathbf{e}}$. Third, § 685a.4(e) (relating to the opening of the table for gaming) states that Subsections (a) and (c) – (e) do not apply if the deck of cards received at the table are preinspected and preshuffled. The reference to Subsections (a) and (c) – (e) should be amended to read Subsections (a) – (d). This would be consistent with other regulations of the Board governing different Blackjack games.
