Dear Mr. Sandusky:

Thank you for allowing Shuffle Master, Inc. ("Shuffle Master") the opportunity to comment on the Temporary Table Games Regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board. After our review, we would like to provide the following comments:

CHAPTER 523. TABLE GAME EQUIPMENT

- § 523.17. Dealing shoes; automated card shuffling devices.

Part (b) number (2) of this section stipulates that the sides of the shoe below the base plate shall: "Be transparent, have a transparent sealed cutout or be otherwise constructed to prevent any object from being placed into or removed from the portion of the dealing shoe below the base plate."

This requirement would expose the visibility of wiring and hardware components of an automated dealing shoe and it would also make the automated dealing shoe not visibly appealing on the table. Shuffle Master recommends that the sides of automated dealing shoes below the base plate are not required to be transparent.
