Dear Mr. Sandusky:

Thank you for allowing Shuffle Master, Inc. ("Shuffle Master") the opportunity to comment on the Temporary Table Games Regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board. After our review, we would like to provide the following comments:

CHAPTER 569. ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLD 'EM POKER

• § 569.10. Procedures for dealing the cards from an automated dealing shoe.

Parts (b) and (c) of this section stipulate procedures for dealing from an automated dealing shoe that do not complement the operation of the automated dealing shoe. An automated dealing shoe dispenses a stack of five community cards first and then dispenses stacks of two cards for the dealer to deliver to each player.

Shuffle Master respectfully requests that this section is revised to allow for an automated dealing shoe to dispense a stack of five community cards first and then dispense stacks of two cards.

• § 569.11. Procedures for completion of each round of play; collection and payment of wagers.

Part (a) of this section stipulates "The player may either check or place a Play Wager in an amount equal to four times the amount of the player's Ante Wager." The rules of play for the game of Ultimate Texas Hold'em Poker allow a player to place a Play Wager in an amount equal to three or four times the amount of the player's Ante Wager, not just four times the amount.
