RULES AND REGULATIONS

TITLE 58. RECREATION

PENNSYLVANIA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

[58 PA. CODE CHS 513]

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§ 513.1. Definitions.

(a) The following words and phrases, when used in this chapter shall have the following meanings unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

Fully executed gaming transaction - Any activity involving a slot machine or associated equipment which occurs on the gaming floor of a licensed gaming facility and which results in an individual obtaining any money or thing of value from, or

being owed any money or thing of value by, a slot machine licensee.

Winnings - Any money or thing of value received from, or being owed by a slot machine licensee as a result of a fully executed gaming transaction.

§ 513.2. Exclusion requirements.

(a) An individual under 18 years of age shall not be on the gaming floor of a licensed facility.

(b) An individual under 21 years of age, whether personally or through an agent, shall not operate, use, play or place a wager on, a slot machine in a licensed facility.

(c) No individual under 21 years of age shall collect in any manner or in any proceeding, whether personally or through an agent, any winnings or recover any losses arising as a result of any gaming activity.

(d) Any winnings incurred by an individual under 21 years of age shall be remitted to the Board and deposited into the Compulsive and Problem Gambling Treatment Fund.

(e) For the purposes of this section, any winnings issued to, found on or about, or redeemed by an individual under 21 years of age shall be presumed to constitute winnings and thus be subject to remittance to the Board.

§ 513.3. Responsibilities of licensees, permittees, registrants and certificate holders.

(a) A person holding a license, permit, registration or certificate issued by the Board is prohibited from permitting or enabling an individual to engage in conduct that violates §§ 513.2(a) or (b).

(b) A slot machine licensee may be subject to Board imposed administrative sanctions if a person engages in conduct that violates §§ 513.2(a), (b) or (c) at their licensed facility. Pursuant to § 513.2(d), any winnings obtained by a slot machine licensee from or held on account of a person under 21 years of age shall be remitted to the Board and deposited into the Compulsive and Problem Gambling Treatment Fund.

(c) Each slot machine licensee shall establish procedures that are designed to prevent violations of this chapter. Each slot machine licensee shall submit to the Board a copy of its procedures 30 days prior to initiation of gaming activities at their licensed facility, and shall not commence operations until the Board approves its procedures. Any amendments to these procedures must receive approval of the Board prior to their implementation.

§ 513.4. Enforcement.

(a) In any prosecution or other proceeding against a person for a violation of this chapter, it shall be no defense that the person believed an individual to be 21 years of age or over.
