**SUPPLEMENT NO. 1 TO GREENWOOD GAMING AND ENTERTAINMENT, INC.'S  
PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT TABLE GAMES  
AND ISSUANCE OF A TABLE GAME OPERATION CERTIFICATE**

Greenwood Gaming and Entertainment, Inc., t/d/b/a Parx Casino f/k/a Philadelphia Park Casino ("GGE", "Parx Casino" or "Philadelphia Park") submits this Supplement No. 1 to its Petition for Approval of Authorization to Conduct Table Games and Issuance of a Table Games Operation Certificate ("Petition") and states in support of this Supplement and its underlying Petition as follows:

1. On February 9, 2010, GGE submitted its Petition to operate table games at its licensed permanent facility.

2. Since filing its Petition, GGE has slightly modified its table games implementation plans as follows:

(a) Appendix 3 to its Petition provides an itemization of the table games for which authorization is sought. Since filing its Petition, GGE has increased the number of live banking games from 54 to 57 and has determined that 9 of those live banking games will be electronic gaming tables. The breakdown of these 57 table games is provided in Updated Appendix 3 which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

(b) As indicated above, GGE has modified its plans to install a total of 57 table games (original plan was 54 tables) during Phase I of table games implementation. In its modified

plans the total number of slot machines which will operated following the completion of Phase 1 has been slightly reduced to 3,376. However, this complement remains larger than the 3,294 slot machines currently in operation and the 2,912 machines in operation as of October 1, 2009. Furthermore, GGE has modified its plan pertaining to the timing of addition and removal of a slot machines during its implementation plan. The breakdown of the addition and removal of machines is attached hereto as Exhibit “B.” It should be noted, however, that GGE is actually adding 207 new slot machines to the gaming floor, but as a result of the conversion of 125 existing electronic blackjack and roulette units (that are approved as slot machines) to 24 fully automated electronic table games, the net addition of slot machines after the table games are installed and the electronic tables are converted will be 83.


(c) Concomitant with the submission of this Supplement, GGE is also submitting Supplement No. 1 to its Petition for Approval of the Expansion of its Existing Gaming Floor which includes the updated floor plans containing the above described modifications – which floor plans are marked as OP-13A. The OP-13A floor plans are incorporated herein by reference as Modified Appendix 10 to the Petition.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> The OP-13 A floor plans also depicts the reconfiguration, renumbering and revised spacing of both slot machines and table games from that which was originally depicted in Appendix 10 and OP-13.

**WHEREFORE**, for all of the foregoing reasons, the Board should grant this Petition and issue a table games operation certificate to GGE.


