SUPPLEMENT NO. 2 TO GREENWOOD GAMING AND ENTERTAINMENT, INC.'S PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT TABLE GAMES AND ISSUANCE OF A TABLE GAME OPERATION CERTIFICATE

Greenwood Gaming and Entertainment, Inc., t/d/b/a Parx Casino f/k/a Philadelphia Park Casino ("GGE", "Parx Casino" or "Philadelphia Park") submits this Supplement No. 2 to its Petition for Approval of Authorization to Conduct Table Games and Issuance of a Table Games Operation Certificate ("Petition") and states in support of this Supplement and its underlying Petition as follows:

- 1. On February 9, 2010, GGE submitted its Petition to operate table games at its licensed permanent facility.
- 2. On March 4, 2010, GGE submitted Supplement No. 1 to its Petition. This supplement made minor modifications regarding the breakdown of table games to be operated and the implementation of Phase I of its transition plan as it relates to removing and adding slot machines on the gaming floor.
- 3. GGE has determined further modifications to its Petition and transition plan are required and submits this Supplement No. 2 in support of its underlying Petition.
- 4. GGE has revised Appendix 3 to its Petition to provide for a reduction in the number of fully automated electronic gaming tables from 24 to 23, and in doing so has eliminated the roulette game previously included. The breakdown of fully automated electronic

gaming tables has also been modified to 12 blackjack games, 10 Three Card Poker games and 1 Baccarat game. An updated Appendix 3 is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

- 5. Along the same lines, GGE had previously proposed that 125 electronic slots positions will be converted to 24 fully automated electronic gaming tables. GGE has determined that the conversion will result in 23 fully automated electronic gaming tables and that an electronic roulette machine (with 10 slot positions) will be eliminated.
- 6. Milestone dates for GGE's Table Games Implementation Plan have been revised as follows: 1) an additional 149 new slots in the East Egress area will be installed by May 1, rather than April 15, 2010; 2) the removal of 282 slot machines in the ellipse area to make way for tables and the addition of 174 new slot machines throughout the casino to occur from May 7 through June 7; and 3) the addition of 166 slots in the north cage shell space, the conversion of 115 e-table slots to 23 fully automated electronic gaming tables and the removal of an electronic roulette machine (with 10 slot positions) will be completed by July 2, 2010. A revised breakdown of the Transition Plan is attached hereto as Exhibit "B."
- 7. Finally, GGE is adding additional table games employment positions to its hiring plan. GGE previously estimated that its table games operations would create 327 jobs. That estimate has now increased to 385 full time employment positions. A revised Appendix 4 which provides a breakdown of the positions is attached hereto as Exhibit "C."

WHEREFORE, for all of the foregoing reasons, the Board should grant this Petition and issue a table games operation certificate to GGE.
